Rhonda and I went shopping for the socks and underwear Tax free weekend and really learned how out of touch we are with kids styles in just the simple things like underwear and socks. Boxers, briefs, boxer briefs, low cut socks, high cut socks, stripes, solids, white, color, bikini cut, boy cut and so on. We had a cart full of different sizes, colors and

cuts. I kept waiting for the lady at the check out to ask how many children we had as she was giving us the quizzical eye, but she refrained.
