We were fortunate enough to be able to return to the orphanage at Calle Domingo Salvio in Guayaquil, Ecuador. This blessed home is a safe haven for the children of Guayaquil who have been abused and neglected. It provides shelter and refuge and life for these orphans.

On Christmas day this past season we kicked off the celebration a little differently than normal. We started with an ice cream party for the children of the orphanage. As Guayaquil sits just below the equator and the heat gets intense, the children were excited to start the beginning of summer with cups of yummy ice cream.

This year our Christmas for Orphans

outreach program was able to continue providing the music program at the orphanage with additional instruments and supplies. Our prayers were answered this year through the help of a local woman who took us to a music store and explained to the owner who the musical gifts were for and the store owner who gifted us with the significant discount that allowed us to purchase more supplies for the orphanage than we thought we could.

This year the orphanage received a bass guitar, a snare drum, a bass drum pedal, a keyboard stand, and guitar strings as well as smaller assorted music supplies. We were also given the ability to provide shoes for 77 of the children at the home. It has been a merry and blessed Christmas season indeed.
