



Where Do I Begin?

"I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

Beginning a journey with Jesus, for many, often starts with reading His word, but reading the Bible cover to cover while trying to understand a personal walk with Jesus for the first time, or again after losing your path, can be a daunting task. Many turn to Bible study plans to help them make sense of all of the new information. However, there are literally hundreds and thousands of different Bible study plans out there. Choosing one that makes sense in one's life can be a difficult process.

It is important to understand that a personal walk with Jesus is not a test of whether you read and understood all of the material first. It is a constant conversation of forgiveness, acceptance, faith, love, and renewal. Jesus says to the people in John 14:6, "I am the way, the truth, and the life." He is there to walk with you, and when you fall, and you will, Jesus is there to remind

you that you need only call upon Him and allow Him to show you the truth, set you on the right way again, and remind you that life through Him is eternal. If you are just beginning to experience conversations with Jesus, or need help finding a good starting point to assist in studying the word of God as well as connecting to it, the following steps could be helpful as a daily guide:

1. Choose a selection of scripture.
2. Read it in context of who is saying it and why it is being said to help understand its meaning and importance.
3. Take some time to think about the ways in which it could relate to your life, thoughts, emotions, or situations.
4. End with a prayer

Once you have identified areas in your life that need the most assistance, it becomes easier to choose a Bible study that is right for you.

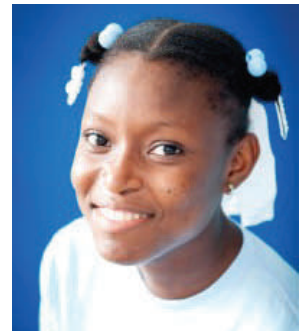
